OUR GOAL

The goal of the Door County Medical Center Dental Clinic is to make certain that every underprivileged child and adult in our community has access to the quality dental care they deserve.

OUR STORY

Started in 1999, the Door County Medical Center Dental Clinic, a non-profit organization, provides services to underprivileged children of Door and Kewaunee Counties. In 2013 we expanded to 4 days a week and included adults.

In January 2016 the clinic expanded to 5 days a week, meeting the ever present need for dental care for low income residents. The clinic is now located at 228 S. 18th Avenue.

MEETING A CRITICAL NEED

The clinic serves more than 4,000 individuals annually, providing cleanings, exams, fillings, extractions, root canals and more to those who would otherwise have been unable to see a dentist.

Access to dental care was recently identified as one of the top three health needs in our community, and the DCMC Dental Clinic is addressing that need, one patient at a time.

The benefits of providing dental care include:

- Increased access to preventative dental care and education for families
- Reduction of oral health disease in our community
- Reduction of child tooth decay, the most common childhood disease
- Decrease in emergency room visits for oral pain
- Decrease in health problems associated with oral disease, including heart problems and chronic infection
