



High School Scholarship Rules

To Apply: You must be a graduating high school senior from one of the following Door County High Schools (Gibraltar, Sevastopol, Southern Door, Sturgeon Bay, Washington Island, and Algoma HS) pursuing an education in the medical field.

Process for submitting forms :

- a. Student must obtain Scholarship Application from his/her HS Guidance Counselor or go to <http://dcmedical.org/Volunteer/Scholarship-Applications>
- b. Student is responsible for giving the Principal, **Form D** as soon as possible.
- c. Student must complete **Forms (A, B & C)** and submit to his/her respective HS Guidance Counselor.
- d. The HS Guidance Counselor will attach **Form D and a copy of the student's transcript** to the application **Forms (A, B & C)** and mail.

The completed application for all applicants is due to Robin Hamm-Jackson by April 9, 2018!

- **Applications received after April 9, 2018, will not be considered.**
- **Incomplete applications will not be considered.**

Awarding of Scholarships will be based on the following criteria:

- a. Applicant must be planning to pursue a full course of studies toward an undergraduate degree at an accredited technical school, 4 year college or university **in the medical field**
- b. Scholastic and academic awards including: rank in class, transcript of grades, ACT/SAT Composite scores, academic awards, honors etc.
- c. Award winners must have maintained a 3.0 or better GPA (based on a 4.0 system)
- d. Extracurricular activities
- e. Community involvement: good citizenship both in school and in the community
- f. Interview before the Auxiliary Scholarship Committee

Notification of award and presentation:

- Awarding of scholarships under this program will be the sole responsibility of the Auxiliary Scholarship Committee along with the cooperation and assistance of certain school personnel. All applications will be considered without regard to the applicant's age, sex, race religion, handicap or other protected categories.
- The school guidance counselor will be notified of all recipients for each school by May 7, 2018.
- Awards will be presented to the students during their high school Senior Awards Recognition Program.
- Scholarship funds are paid directly to the student (including the school name).
